6. 次の文章を読んで問いに答えなさい。

“Universal design” is the philosophy of creating city facilities, living environments, and designs which can be used easily by anyone – regardless of their age, ability, or physical condition. Its basis is that diversity is normal. Universal design is for everyone, because we all should enjoy living together.

It’s not difficult to find examples of this type of design in everyday life. Think about vending machines. Until recently, ① they usually had a small place to put in coins. That makes vending machines harder to operate for someone who cannot use his or her hands fully. Newer machines, however, have a larger place for coins. The buttons to choose the items are not too high, and the opening for the items is not too low, either. This makes ② it much easier for someone in a wheelchair to use a vending machine.

Thanks to this design philosophy, more companies provide products, facilities, and services which are easy for many people to use. Universal design is good for both business and society.
